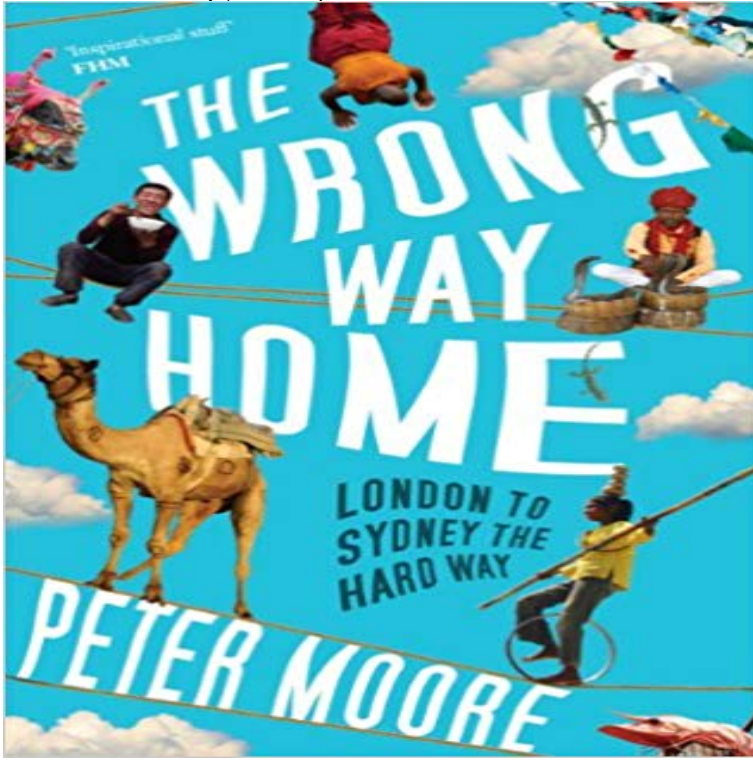


# The Wrong Way Home
