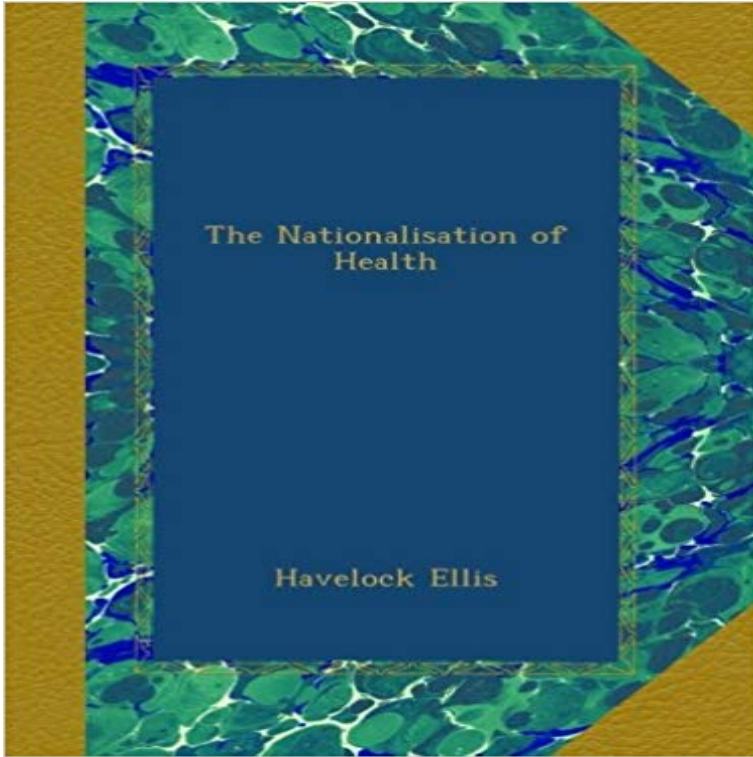


The Nationalisation of Health
