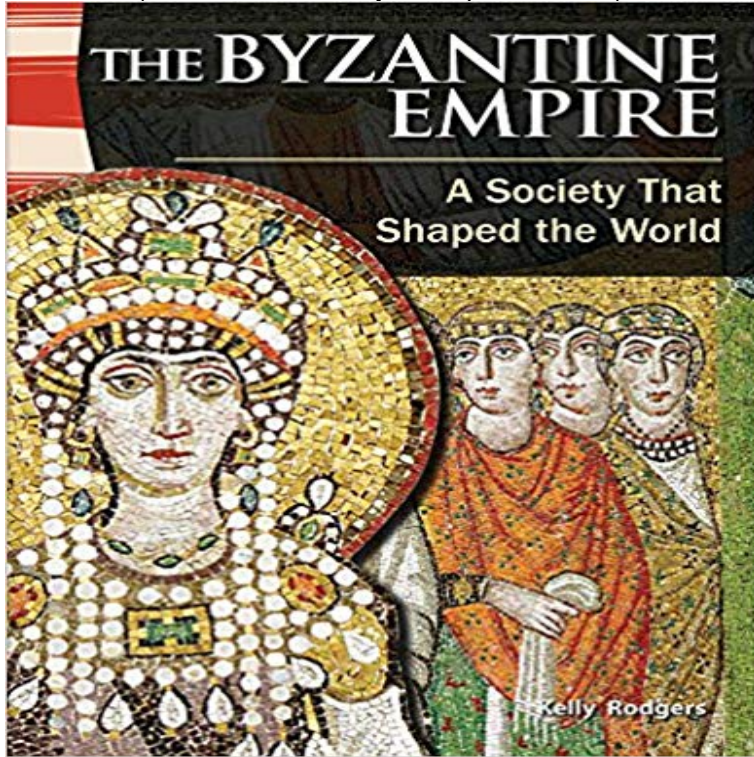


The Byzantine Empire (Primary Source Readers)
