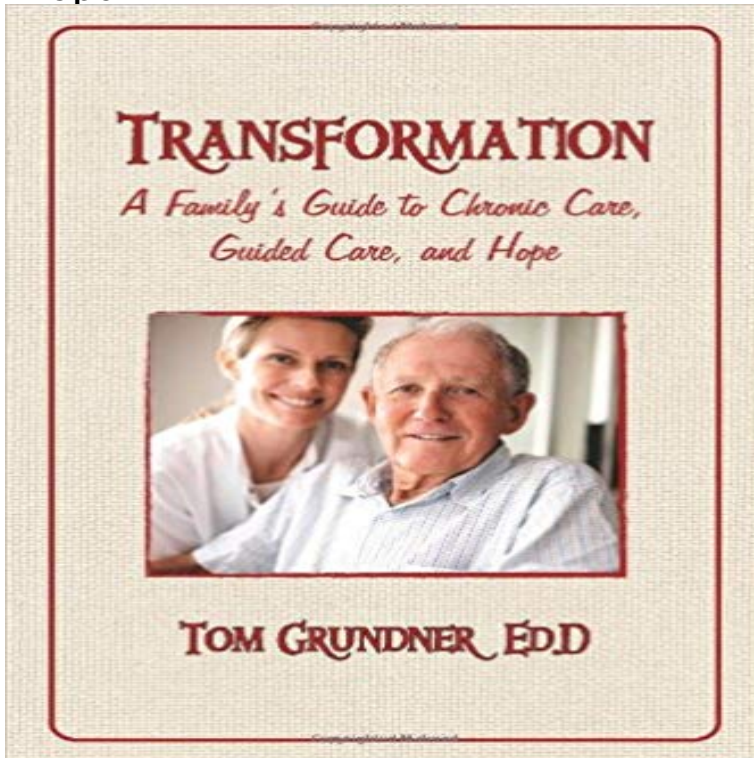


Transformation: A Family's Guide to Chronic Care, Guided Care, and Hope
