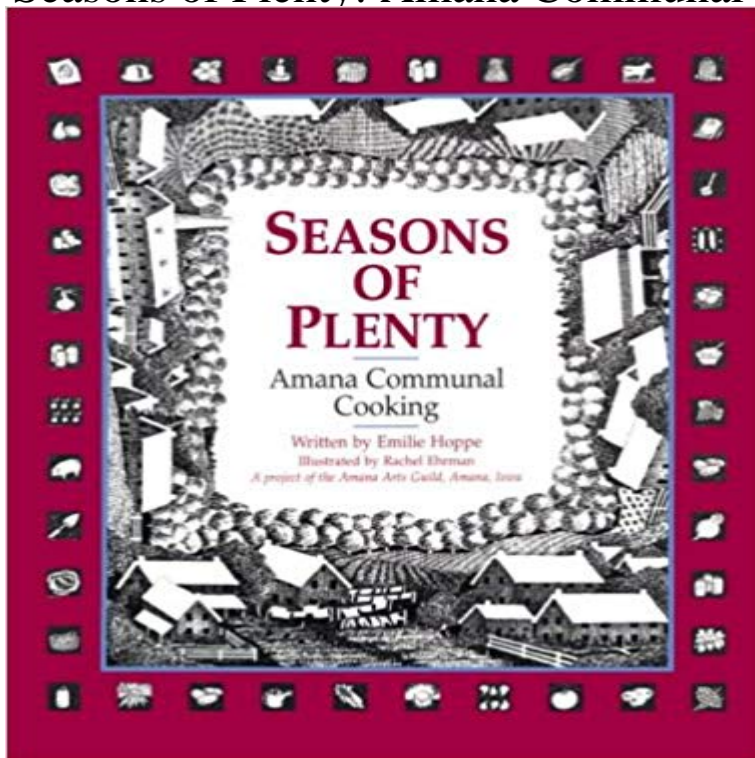


Seasons of Plenty: Amana Communal Cooking
